Boardroom


In the Boardroom conference room, there will be a total of 4 computers that need to be connected. They are called BoardDocs, Clerk, Vote, and Podium. The BoardDocs, Clerk and Vote laptops are connected on the left hand side of the stage. The Voting laptop is connected at the end of the stage, followed by the Clerk laptop then the BoardDocs laptop. The Voting Laptop is connected next to the Crestron Tablet and the person using the Voting Laptop also controls which laptop is displayed on the monitors by using the Crestron Tablet. Press the On Button to turn on the Tablet. See below for an image of the Crestron Tablet.




Once it is on, press the "Begin" option to open up the main menu of the Creston Tablet.



When the main menu appears, the Voting laptop user can select which computer to be displayed on the monitors.




The Voting Laptop is the laptop that has an IR adaptor on the right side and must be connected next to the Crestron tablet. See below.


